Mr. Mathews, from the committee on the Library, reported back to the House the accounts of J. Sheehy, J. S. Waters and J. W. White;

Which was received and referred to the committee on Claims.

Mr. Price, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported unfavorably upon the bill entitled, An act to amend the 2d section of an act entitled, An act to repeal the 19th section, of the 29th article of the Code of Public General Laws, and the proviso of the 33d section of the 5th article of said Code relating to the stay of execution and to extend the time for enforcing the execution of judgments, passed May 10th, 1861;

Mr. Hammond, of Howard, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported unfavorably upon the bill entitled, An act to amend the 86th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto the following sections, giving authority to the Secretary of State to charge fees for certain services;

Which reports were received and the bills laid on the table.

Mr. Donaldson, from the committee on Ways and Means, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend the 268th section, of the 93rd article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the accounts and payments into the treasury of registers of wills;

Also, a bill entitled, An act to amend the 9th and 10th sections, of the 18th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the clerks of courts, their accounts and payments into the Treasury;

Mr. Phelps, from the same committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend the 86th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto the following sections, imposing a tax on the commissions of certain officers;

Mr. Price, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to repeal section 5, of article 18, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Clerks of Courts, relating to the issuing of executions, from one county to another, and to re-enact the same with amendments thereto;
