The Senate bill entitled, An act to authorise the trustees of primary school district number nineteen, of Anne Arundel county, to sell the lot of ground on which the old school house is built, and to select a site and build a new school house in a more central place, and to authorise the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to levy one hundred dollars on the assessable property of said county for building said school house;
