

Mr. Donaldson proposed the following amendments:

Strike out all of 143rd line and to the word "dollars," in the 144th line;

Strike out 148th line and thence to end of the first section and insert as follows:

"Keeper of the steam house and the furnace of the record building, four hundred and twenty dollars, and for the salary of the assistant keeper, three hundred and sixty dollars, to the person employed by the clerk of the Court of Appeals for keeping the court rooms clean, the sum of five dollars a month, sixty dollars;"

Which were adopted.
