Governor, to communicate with the President of the United States in relation to the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, and concur therein.

We have appointed Messrs. Hammond, of Howard, Warner and Magruder, the committee on the part of this House.

On motion of Mr. Mathews, The rules were suspended, and

Leave was granted to the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled, An act to amend an act passed on May 10th, 1861, entitled, an act to repeal the 19th section of the 29th article of the Code of Public General Laws, and the proviso to the 33d section of the 5th article of said Code, relating to stay of execution, and to extend the time for enforcing the execution of judgments, by making said stay conditional.

On motion of Mr. Magruder, The rules were suspended, and

Leave was granted the committee on Claims to introduce a bill to regulate the mileage of the members of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and prescribing the officers to be chosen by the two Houses respectively, and their duties and compensation.

Mr. Donaldson submitted the following joint resolutions:

Resolved by the Senate and House of Delegates of the State of Maryland, That the Constitution of the United States, so admirably framed by the wisdom of our forefathers, is recognized by the people of Maryland as the great charter of their liberties, the foundation, support and protection of their rights, and the main source of all their prosperity; that they are at all times ready cordially to renew the expression of their devotion to its principles; that they unreservedly acknowledge the supremacy of all laws made in pursuance thereof, and repudiate every construction of that instrument which would destroy its efficiency, its very existence, indeed, by the assertion of any right, expressed, implied or reserved in the States, to secede from the Union; and although they consider the right of revolution, for justifiable cause, inherent in every people, they unhesitatingly declare that they know no existing cause to justify the people of the United States in attempting the overthrow of their government.
