

An act to incorporate the City Park Railway Company;

An act to amend the 80th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto the following sections, imposing a tax on the commissions of certain officers;

An act to pay Aza Beall, of Allegany county, a sum of money therein mentioned;

An act to add new sections to article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Calvert county, regulating the taking and catching of oysters in the waters of said county;

An act to add new sections to article 12, of the Code of Public Laws, for Harford county relating to fences;

An act to incorporate the Potomac Improvement Company;

An act for the relief of Levin S. H. Smith, of Worcester county;

An act to provide for the division of the large room under the State Library in the State House in the city of Annapolis, into three rooms of convenient size, and to have the same fitted up for committee rooms;

An act to authorise the Treasurer to pay to the commissioners of Howard county for the use of academies and schools in Howard county, the annual sum heretofore granted to the Patapsco Institute;

An act to add a new section to article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, for Allegany county, to regulate the public advertising in said county;

An act for the relief of Sarah A. Reynolds, formerly Sarah A. Denny, of New Castle county, in the State of Delaware, by authorising the circuit court for Cecil county to direct a conveyance of certain real estate, lying and being in Cecil county, Maryland, sold to her by John B. Rowan, trustee, and making certain docket entries, of said court, evidence;

An act to authorise Joshua Dill, administrator of Jacob Hill, a free negro deceased, to pay over the balance upon settlement of the final account of the estate of said deceased, to Richard H. Murdock, of Frederick county, in trust for the use and benefit of George Hill, son of said Jacob Hill, who is the slave of the said Murdock;

An act to authorise and require the county commissioners of each of the counties of Prince George's and Anne Arundel counties, to levy a sum of money to repair or rebuild a bridge across the Patuxent river known by the name of Bealmere's bridge;

An act to make valid a deed from William D. Croper and Rebecca W. Croper, his wife, of Accomac county in the State
