An act to authorise the clerk of the circuit court of Caroline county to deliver the docket and other papers of William Lockerman, late magistrate, to his successor in office;

An act to compensate the members of the Peace Conference, appointed by the Executive of the State, to represent Maryland, at Washington, during the winter of 1861;

An act to incorporate the Locust Point Steam Ferry Company of Baltimore city;

An act to make valid and effectual the will of Elizabeth Delauter, widow of David Delauter, deceased, of Frederick county, in regard to the real property therein devised;

An act to add the following section to article 66 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Free Negroes, to authorise free negroes to hold, alienate and transfer real and personal property in this State, and to make their children capable of receiving and inheriting the same;

An act to make an appropriation to compensate that portion of the 16th Regiment of Maryland Militia, which, in obedience to an order of His Excellency, Governor Hicks, performed guard duty at the State armory, in Frederick, from April 22d to May 11th, 1861, inclusive;

An act to amend the 30th section, of the 5th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to appeals;

An act to incorporate the Bank of Elkton;

An act to authorise the county commissioners for Prince George's county, to pay Daniel Garner, John R. Baden and William B.
