An act to add additional sections to article 4 of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, relative to lumber;

An act relating to the issuing of executions on judgments obtained at the suit of and for the benefit of the State;

An act to amend the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, by repealing sections 474, 475, 476, 477, 478, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484 and 485 of said article, relating to lumber, and enacting in lieu thereof the following sections;

An act to amend article 71 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Oysters, regulating the taking and catching of oysters within the waters of this State;

An act to amend the 16th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto the following, relating to the powers of courts of chancery in selling land;

An act to incorporate the Tygart Mountain Coal and Manufacturing Company of Allegany county, Maryland;

The bill entitled, An act to amend the 9th and 10th sections, of the 18th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the clerks of courts, their accounts and payments into the Treasury;

Was read the third time.

On motion of Mr. Donaldson,

The following amendment was adopted:

In 1st section, strike out from line 6 inclusive, to line 10 inclusive, and insert:

Every clerk, except the Clerk of the Court of Appeals, the emoluments of whose office shall exceed the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars in any one year, after deducting therefrom the necessary expenses incident to his office, for the same period, shall pay the excess to the Treasurer; and the Clerk of the Court of Appeals shall pay the excess over the sum of three thousand dollars, after making the deductions aforesaid.
