The bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Cecil and Harford counties Boom Company;

Pending which,

Mr. Ensor proposed the following:

Sec. 19. After the word "existence," and before the word "and," in 32d line: "Provided that the said company shall only have the right to acquire by condemnation, or purchase such land as may be necessary for the purpose contemplated by this act;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Alexander proposed the following:

"Sec. 23. And be it enacted, That the company hereby incorporated shall, within sixty days after it goes into operation, give bond to the State of Maryland, with security to be approved by the Governor, in the penalty of one hundred thousand dollars, conditioned for the payment into the Treasury, quarterly, of one-fourth of all the boomage which may be received by said company;"

Which was adopted.

Also, proposed the following:

Sec. 10. Line 4, after the word "scale," insert "one-fourth of which shall be paid into the Treasury of the State for the use of the State;"
