Mr. Creswell proposed the following:

"Section And be it enacted, That after paying six per cent. interest on the capital stock of said company, and all the expenses and repairs thereof, the residue of the profits thereof shall be paid over to the Treasurer of the State for use of the State; and, to secure the interest of the State in said profits it is hereby further enacted, that the Commissioners of Public Works of the State shall be and they are hereby authorised to appoint two directors on the part of the State in said corporation;"

Upon which the yeas and nays being ordered, the amendment was rejected as follow:
