

An act to authorise James A. Thompson, of Queen Anne's county, to bring into the State of Maryland, a bound negro boy;

An act to allow a pension to Joseph Romiser, of Allegany county;

An act to authorise the Armorer at Frederick city, to contract for the altering and repairing flint lock muskets belonging to the State of Maryland, now in possession of the several captains in Frederick county;

An act appropriating a sum of money to pay Elenora B. Watkins, widow of the late Col. Gassaway Watkins, a captain in the American Revolution, on account of pension money due and unpaid from the 16th day of July, 1840, to the 1st of January, 1852;

An act to authorise the clerk of the circuit court for Washington county, to record a deed from William B. McAtee to Jacob M. Miller;

An act to designate the place of holding elections in district number three in Washington county;

An act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1847, chapter 160, entitled, An act to make a turnpike road in Washington county;

An act to allow J. T. Hoxton, late collector of taxes of Prince George's county, further time to complete his collections;

An act for the relief of Richard W. Hook, former sheriff of Baltimore county;
