

EVENING SESSION, 7½ o'clock.

Mr. Davis, of Montgomery, by permission of the House, submitted the following

REPORT:

The committee appointed by the House, in conjunction with a similar committee on the part of the Senate, to wait upon Brigadier General Foster, to notify him of the acceptance by the Legislature of his polite invitation to attend a military review to-morrow, beg leave to report that they have performed that duty; and after being received very courteously by General Foster, attended by his aids, and introduced to staff officers, they communicated to him the acceptance of his invitation by both Houses of the General Assembly.

General Foster requested the committee to report that the review was expressly in honor of His Excellency, the Governor and the Legislature of Maryland; and that it would take place near the camp ground, about one mile distant from the city of Annapolis, precisely at the hour of 10 o'clock, A. M., and that the members of the Legislature would be received in the mode most agreeable to themselves, at the same time tendering to them a military escort, which the committee however respectfully declined.

The committee, therefore, recommend that the members of the House assemble at the State House, at the hour of nine o'clock to-morrow morning, at which time and place it is understood the Senators will also assemble, and from thence proceed in a body to the field of the review.
