Mr. Smith, from the committee on Printing, submitted the following

REPORT:

The joint committee on Printing beg leave to report—

That they have contracted with Thomas J. Wilson, in accordance with section 5, of article 76, of the Code of Public General Laws, for the printing of one thousand copies of the Laws and Resolutions passed at the present session of the General Assembly, with the index and titles of the same, on sized and calendered paper, at least equal in quality to that on which the Code of Public General and Local Laws were printed, at the rate of one dollar and seventy-five cents per page of sixteen hundred and fifty ems. The said copies to be delivered to the State Librarian within fifty days after the adjournment of the present Legislature.

And the committee further report, that the said Thomas J. Wilson has entered into bond to the State of Maryland, approved by the State Treasurer, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned for the proper and faithful performance of his contract.

The committee further report that they have contracted with John G. Taylor, of Annapolis city, for preparing an index to said Laws and Resolutions, and supervising the proof sheets of the same, for the sum of two hundred dollars, and the said Taylor has given bond to the State of Maryland, approved by the State Treasurer, for the proper execution of the aforesaid contract.

The committee also report, that the expense of the printing for the Extra session was: for the House printing, seven hundred and forty-eight dollars and fifty-seven cents, and for the Senate printing, nine hundred and nine dollars and fifty cents; and for the whole printing, including that amount and except for the Journal of Proceedings, which is not yet completed, ten thousand two hundred and eighty-eight dollars and twenty-six cents; as will be seen by the account of the Printers, which is herewith annexed and made a part of this Report, to be printed therewith.
