

The bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 806, 807, 809, 810, 811, 815 and 821 of article 4th of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments thereto;

Was read the second time.

Mr. Donaldson moved to amend as follows:

In the 58th line, 1st section, strike out the words "remaining commissioners or a majority of them" and insert the word "Governor;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Magruder moved to amend as follows:

In section 2, lines 19 and 20, strike out the words "State Department," and insert "Office of the Secretary of State."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Mathews moved to amend as follow:

In the 62d line, strike out "the" and insert "its;" and strike out the words "of the Legislature;"

In 61st line, reinstate the words "which appointment shall be made;"

In 4th line, 5th section, strike out "nine" and insert "ten;"

In lines 14 and 15 of section 1, strike out the words "fifteen hundred" and insert "twelve hundred and fifty;"

Which were adopted.

Mr. Magruder moved to amend as follows:

Section 3, line 26, strike out the words "for five years" and insert "during good behavior;"

Which was rejected.

On motion of Mr. Mathews,

The rules were suspended, and the bill was read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
