An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claims of Charles Reeder, Philip T. Tyson and the estate of Thomas Gardiner;

An act to compensate Randall & Hagner and William Price for legal services rendered by order of the Governor;

An act to compensate Milton Whitney for legal services rendered by order of the Governor;

An act to compensate Edwin H. Webster, Ezekiel F. Chambers, William H. Dallam and Henry Stockbridge, for legal services rendered by order of the Governor;

An act to repeal an act passed on the 20th of June, 1861, at the extra session of the General Assembly, chapter 72, entitled, An act to make valid the qualification of Tench Tilghman as Major General of the second division of Maryland Militia;

An act to make an appropriation to compensate that portion of the 16th Regiment Maryland Militia which, in obedience to an order of His Excellency, Governor Hicks, performed guard duty at the State Armory in Frederick, from April 22d to May 1861, inclusive;

An act to repeal an act passed in 1856, chapter 145, entitled, An act to incorporate the Farmers' and Merchants' Bank of Cecil county;

An act to amend section 3, of article 42, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the office of Governor, and to re-enact the same;

An act to amend the charter of the Hagerstown Bank, as contained in the act entitled, An act to continue the corporate existence of the several banking institutions therein mentioned passed at the January session, 1853, chapter 441;

An act to repeal sections 174 and 175, of article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, crimes and punishments, relating to runaways;

An act to empower the mayor and city council of Baltimore to levy and collect taxes on all property within the corporate limits of the city which is not otherwise exempted from taxation;

An act to make valid the election of the committee of the Presbyterian Church in Snow Hill, in Worcester county, and to regulate the election of said committee in future;
