

APPROPRIATION BILL, GENERAL—Bill favorably reported for making appropriations for the support of Government, 660, read second time, 691; 692, proceedings on, 694, 695, 696, passed, 718.

Bill favorably reported for the support of Government in 1864, 660, proceedings on, 717, 718, read the third time and passed, 719.

ANNAPOLIS AND ELKRIDGE RAILROAD COMPANY, leave was granted a select committee to report a bill to amend act passed December, 1846, chapter 234, supplemental to an act passed December session 1841, chapter 168, 296, referred to the committee on Ways and Means, 317, reported with amendments, laid on the table, 369; read third time and passed, 578.

BALTIMORE CITY—Leave to introduce a bill to repeal section 807, of article 4, of Public Local Laws, known as the police bill, 20, 78.

Leave granted to repeal the act to amend sections 806, 807, 809, 815, 816 and 818, 4th article of Public Local Laws, 21; bill reported favorably, read first time and ordered to be printed, proceedings on, and passed, 89; returned from the Senate, passed with amendments, laid on the table, 331; House refused to concur, 340; conference committee, 364; report of proceedings on, passed 406; amendments concurred in, passed, 443.

Leave was granted the delegation from the city of Baltimore to report a bill for the improvement of the public health in, 157.

Bill favorably reported to authorise the court of appeals at December term, 1861, to hear and determine certain appeals in cases of petition upon writs of mandamus in relation to Holliday street, 147, 159; rejected, 189; vote reconsidered, 212; rejected and reconsidered, 261; read third time and passed, 350; returned from the Senate passed, 391.
