Petition of Thomas J. R. Dixon, praying for compensation for surveys and drawings for alteration of State House, referred to, 213.

Leave granted to report a bill to pay to William W. Johnston, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury, 216.

Petition of Harvey F. Johnson, of Somerset county, praying payment of a claim, referred to, 218; reported unfavorably, 407.

Petition of Thomas B. Gaither, praying payment of a claim against the State, referred, 218.

Memorial of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad praying payment of claims for advances to pay State troops, &c., referred, 218.

Petition of Levin Woolford, clerk of the circuit court for Somerset county, asking payment of fees, &c., referred, 222.

A bill from the Senate to compensate George W. Jefferson, for extra services in the Executive Department, referred, 230; passed and returned to the Senate, 234.

Petition of William Lockerman, praying the return of certain taxes overpaid into the Treasury, referred, 232; reported unfavorably, 407.

Petition of Gerard W. Crain, clerk of the circuit court for Charles county, asking compensation for extra work done, referred, 232.

Petition of Mathews C. Pearce, asking indemnity for loss sustained by the hanging of his negro, referred, 246.
