

CLAIMS—

Leave granted committee on Library to report bill to pay E. M. Shipley, for making catalogue of books, and R. F. Bonsall for printing the same, 561.

Leave granted the committee on, to bring in a bill to compensate Messrs. Randall, Hagner and Price for legal services rendered, bill reported, 609; read the second time, amendment, 720; passed, 730, returned from the Senate endorsed, 901.

A bill appropriating a sum of money to pay Elenora B. Watkins, widow of late Col. Gassaway Watkins, unpaid from 16th February 1840 to first January 1852, read the first time, 774; read second time, 861; read the third time and passed, 843.

An act appropriating a sum of money as compensation to Neilson Poe for services rendered the State as counsel by appointment of the Governor, read the first time, 816; reported favorably, 825; read the second time, 825.

Leave was granted a select committee to introduce a bill to amend sections 40, 54 and 55 of article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Clerks of Courts, relating to the making and transmitting of extracts of deeds by, to the Court of Appeals, 162; favorable report, and referred to committee on the Judiciary, 196; read second time and amended, 567.

Leave was granted a select committee to report a bill to amend sections 9 and 10 of article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, relating to their emoluments, and requiring them to pay into the Treasury the excess over the amount limited by the Constitution, 198; bill reported, read second time, 721; passed, 740; reconsidered and laid on the table, 745; read the third time, amended and passed, 762.
