

CLERKS OF COURTS—

Order to the clerk of the Court of Appeals to report the amount of fees, &c., pay of assistants, &c.

Reported favorably a bill to repeal section 5 of article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the issuing of executions from one county to another, and to re-enact the same with amendment thereto, 490; read first time, 639.

CLERKS AND REGISTERS—Reported favorably a bill to amend 146th section of the 81st article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to payments into the Treasury of certain taxes received by, 399.

COLORED POPULATION—Petition from citizens of Worcester county, praying for an act for the more speedy apprehension of runaway slaves, 49; bill reported, read first and second time and ordered to be printed, 64; read third time, 102; proceedings on, and passed, 106.

Preamble and resolutions relating to slavery, from the Senate, read the first time, and by special order passed, 92; proceedings on, 93.

Petition of judges of Orphans' court of Montgomery county, in reference to free persons of color coming into this State, referred to committee on, 174.

The bill for the relief of Samuel Maynard and family, pending its second reading was referred to, 268; unfavorable report adopted, 289.

Bill reported favorably to repeal section 47 of article 66 of the Code of Public General Laws, and to enact additional sections, read first time, 328; read the second time, 453; read third time and passed, 501, 502.

Petition from Gassaway Winterson and others, praying that Jacob Dennis, free negro, may be permitted to convey and devise his property, referred to committee on, 336.
