

COSTS—Leave granted to report a bill to amend article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws; entitled, 253; reported and read first time, 255; referred to committee on Judiciary, 311.

A bill to prevent the accumulation of, in appeal cases, 490.

COURTS—Leave granted to introduce a bill to repeal and amend sections 161, &c., of the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the superior court and court of common pleas, 21.

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to report a bill for the dispatch of business in the circuit courts of the counties, 31.

Leave was granted a special committee to introduce a bill to amend the 16th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto sections in relation to the powers of the court of chancery in selling lands, 160; read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary, 170; reported favorably and read first time, 297; read second time, 457; read third time and passed, 505.

Leave granted to report a bill to add a new sections to the 29th article of the Code of Public General Laws relating to, 260; read the second time and amended, 325; read third time and passed, 381.

Leave granted a select committee to introduce a bill to amend the 43d section of the 29th article of Code of Public General Laws relating to the attendance of crier and sheriff in court of appeals, 356; bill reported, read first time, 362; read second time, 412; and passed, 430; returned from Senate endorsed, 564.

CRIMES AND PUNISHMENTS—Bill favorably reported by select committee to add new sections to article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, to provide for the punishment of persons who may sell merchandise being transported on highways, railroads and canals without the consent, &c., read the first time, 317; read second time, and by special order, and passed, 377; returned with amendment, amendment concurred in, and passed, 442.
