

INSPECTIONS—

relating to the inspection of tobacco, and the appointment and term of office of tobacco inspectors, 356.

Leave granted committee on, to report a bill to amend article 4 of Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, relating to the inspection of lumber, by repealing sections from 474 to 485, both inclusive of said article, and substituting, 356; reported favorably, 438.

Leave granted committee on, to report a bill to alter and amend so much of article 4 of Code of Public Local Laws relating to city of Baltimore, as proposes to regulate the inspection of flour in said city, being from section 330 to 353, inclusive, 560.

Leave to report bill to regulate the, of guano in the city of Baltimore, 561; reported favorably and read the first time, 582; read third time and passed, 875.

Leave granted the committee on Inspections, to report a bill to regulate the inspection of flour, rye flour, corn meal, in the city of Baltimore, and to prevent frauds upon purchasers, 573; reported favorably, 609; read by special order and passed, 768; returned from Senate, amended, concurred in and passed, 898.

Also, bill to regulate the inspection of lime and leather in the city of Baltimore, 573.

An act to repeal 412th section, of article 4, of Code Public Local Laws, relating to the, of hay, and section 414, article 4, Code Public Local Laws, &c., read first time, 595; read the third time and passed, 806.

INDICTMENTS—Bill favorably reported, to amend the law relating to, by adding to the 30th article of Code of Public General Laws relating to, for forging or uttering forged instruments, and for false pretenses, &c., 360; read the second time, proceedings on, 464; read the second time, proceedings on, 464; read the third time and passed, 595; title amended, 595; and sent to Senate.
