

## JUDICIARY COMMITTEE—

Leave granted the committee on the, to introduce a bill to amend an act passed May, 1861, to repeal the 19th section of the Code of Public General Laws, &c., and to extend the time for enforcing the execution of judgments, &c., 71.

Memorial of John F. Miller and others asking a reduction of fees in the court of appeals, referred to, 107.

Leave granted committee on, to introduce a bill requiring jurors to take the oath of allegiance, 110; amendment proposed, 111; committee discharged from further consideration, and referred to joint committee on oath of allegiance, 175.

Leave granted the committee on, to introduce a bill to amend the 13th section of the 29th article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the inspection of records by the judges, 128.

Leave granted, to introduce a bill to prevent accumulation of costs in the court of appeals, 128; bill reported, 141.

Leave granted to introduce a bill to prohibit sale of liquors to soldiers and minors, 128.

Leave granted the committee on, to introduce a bill to extend the time for the redemption of property sold for taxes, 123; bill reported, 406.

Leave granted committee on, to introduce a bill providing that all officers shall take the oath of allegiance to the United States, 129; and message from the Senate proposing a joint committee to report a bill for the same purpose, 129; committee discharged from further consideration and referred to joint committee, 175.

Leave granted committee on, to introduce a bill to amend the 2d section of an act to repeal 19th section of the 29th article of Public General Laws, &c., relating to the stay of execution on judgments, 132; read first time, 142; bill reported favorably, 287; remonstrance against further stay, 295.
