

## JUDICIARY COMMITTEE—

Leave granted a select committee to introduce a bill to repeal section 5 of article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws relating to the issuing of execution from one county to another, 135; favorable report and referred to, 136.

Bill reported to add a section to 10th article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to attachments, 141; read and referred to.

Petition of Felix Van Reuth praying relief for injuries occasioned to property during the mob of April in the city of Baltimore, 144; unfavorable report adopted, 165.

Leave granted the committee on, to introduce a bill to prohibit the clerks of the several courts of this State from practising law therein, 149.

Leave granted committee on, to introduce a bill to add an additional section to article 2, of the Code of Public General Laws in relation to abatements, 157; read second time, 258; read third time and passed, 312.

Bill reported favorably to amend the law in regard to prayers and instructions in trials at law and appeals, 159; read second time, 248; amended, passed and sent to the Senate, 258.

Leave granted committee on, to introduce a bill to authorise Ebenezer L. Wailes to settle his account as guardian to Charles A. Wailes and to deliver over his estate, 162; bill reported favorably, 207; read second time and by order passed, 381.

Bill reported by committee on, to ratify an amendment to the Constitution of the United States proposed by Congress to the Legislatures of the several States, read first time and by special order and passed, 164; returned from the Senate passed, 173.

Favorable report of a select committee to amend the 93d article of the Code of Public General Laws relating to testamentary law, by adding a section thereto, relating to devises and bequests and the construction importing the failure of issue, referred to committee on, 193.
