

## MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL—

Laws, relating to the time of election of, 320; read first time, 341; proceedings, 394, 395; made the order of the day for February 17; re-committed to Baltimore city delegation, 480.

Leave was granted select committee to report a bill to declare vacant the of, George W. Brown, as Mayor of the city of Baltimore, &c. 677; bill reported, read first time, 694; read second time, 711.

Reported favorably a bill to amend 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto the following section, empowering mayor and city council of Baltimore, to levy an additional tax on all persons selling liquors, &c., to aid in paving streets, &c., read first time, 568.

Leave to introduce a bill to repeal 4th article of Public Local Laws, empowering the, to raise and appropriate money for defense, &c., 22; read second time and amended, 566.

Leave to introduce a bill to repeal the act to confirm ordinance of, to raise five hundred thousand dollars, 22.

Leave to introduce a bill to repeal an act authorising the, to increase public debt of city, 22.
