Petition of Henry Price, colored, praying the passage of a law allowing his sons to return to Maryland, referred, 242.

Petition of Gabriel Bulah and James Friend, praying the passage of a law allowing them to hold certain real estate, &c., referred, 242; read the second time and rejected for want of a constitutional vote, 886; reconsidered and laid on table, 892.

Leave was granted a select committee, to report a bill to amend section 194, of article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, crimes and punishments, relating to the sentence of, 276; reported favorably, read first time, 299; substitute offered, 322.
