

## NEGROES—

Leave was granted a special committee, to report a bill to amend the 53 and 56th sections, of 66th article, of Code Public General Laws, relating to vagrant free, 296; favorable report, 317; amendment adopted, 334; amendment adopted, 382; and passed, 426; returned from Senate endorsed, enacting clause stricken out.

Reported favorably, a bill to repeal section 79, of article 16, of Code of Public Local Laws, under the heading of negroes and slaves, read the first time, 581; read third time and rejected for want of a constitutional vote, 874.

Bill to compel, to perform a limited amount of labor on public roads in Queen Anne's county.
