

## TESTAMENTARY LAW—

article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, relating to the entering of claims against deceased persons, &c, 286; referred to committee on Judiciary, 370; read the second time, 521; read the third time and passed, 632.

Leave was granted a select committee to report a bill to amend sections 291, 292 of article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, providing that in all cases of administration, the widow may apply to her own use, a certain portion of the personal property of deceased, 286; reported favorably and referred to committee on the Judiciary, 317, 382; reported favorably, 490; passed, 656; returned from the Senate, passed, 735.

Reported favorably a bill to amend the 93rd article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Testamentary Law, by adding section thereto, relating to devises and bequests, and construction of words importing failure of issue, 490; read the second time and amended, 566; read third time and passed, returned from Senate, endorsed, 845.

Leave granted select committee to report bill to amend section 280 of article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, relating to the sale of real estate by executors, 573; reported favorably, and read first time and referred to committee on Ways and Means, 575; read third time and passed, 872.

**TILGHMAN, TENCH, MAJOR GENERAL**—A bill to make valid the qualification of, read and referred to the committee on Militia, read the third time and passed, 804.

**TOBACCO WAREHOUSES**—Leave granted a select committee to introduce a bill to amend an act passed January, 1862, authorising the adjustment of accounts of J. G. O'Hara and others, clerks in, 198; reported, read first and second time, 219; passed and sent to the Senate, 237.
