SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

38A.

- (A) (1) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF A WINE TASTING (WT) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- (2) THE LICENSE IS ISSUED ONLY TO HOLDERS OF A BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (BWL) OR A BEER AND WINE (BW) LICENSE.
- (3) THE LICENSE PERMITS THE CONSUMPTION OF WINE, CONTAINING NOT MORE THAN 14 PERCENT OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME, FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES ONLY.
- (4) THE LICENSEE MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN 1 OUNCE FROM EACH GIVEN BRAND TO ANY ONE PERSON.
 - (5) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE:
- (I) FOR HOLDERS OF A (BWL) LICENSE, IS \$100 IN ADDITION TO THE COST OF THE (BWL) LICENSE; AND
- (II) FOR HOLDERS OF A (BW) LICENSE, IS \$100 IN ADDITION TO THE COST OF THE (BW) LICENSE.
- (B) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT RULES OR REGULATIONS PROVIDING ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 56

(House Bill 927)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Food Allowance for Prisoners

FOR the purpose of repealing an obsolete provision relating to the daily food allowance given to the sheriff of Cecil County for the prisoners of the county.
