(B) REPORTS.

SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THIS TITLE, THE COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

(1) AN ANNUAL REPORT, WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONVENES FOR A REGULAR SESSION; AND

(2) ANY OTHER REPORT THAT THE COMMITTEE CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.

2-908. MEMBERSHIP OF COMMISSION.

(A) COMPOSITION.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF AN EQUAL NUMBER OF SENATORS AND DELEGATES.

(B) APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

(1) THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT THE SENATORS ON THE COMMISSION.

(2) THE SPEAKER SHALL APPOINT THE DELEGATES ON THE COMMISSION.
