SUBTITLE 11. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS ON COMMITTEES.

2-1101. DUTIES OF PRESIDING OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

WHEN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT IN SESSION, ANY DECISION THAT RELATES TO OR AFFECTS A MEMBER OF A COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL BE MADE:

- (1) AS TO A SENATE MEMBER, BY THE PRESIDENT; AND
- (2) AS TO A HOUSE MEMBER, BY THE SPEAKER.

(B) SPECIFIC DUTIES.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER UNDER THIS SECTION INCLUDE:

- (1) APPOINTING MEMBERS OF COMMITTEES;
- (2) APPOINTING OFFICERS OF COMMITTEES; AND
- (3) SETTING THE DATES, TIMES, AND PLACES FOR COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

In subsection (b) of this section, the former phrase "but not limited to" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "includes" and "including".

2-1102. STANDING COMMITTEES CONTINUED.
