

Former Art. 40, § 61E, which made it a criminal offense for a person "subject to orders ... issued by the joint [budget and audit] committee" to refuse knowingly to comply with an order, is deleted as obsolete, since Ch. 604, Acts of 1980, rewrote former Art. 40, § 61B and, in doing so, deleted the authorization for the Committee to issue orders and directives.

2-1226. DIVISION DIRECTOR.

(A) POSITION AND APPOINTMENT.

THE HEAD OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET REVIEW IS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION, WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER.

(B) TENURE.

(1) FOR 1 YEAR AFTER APPOINTMENT, THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET REVIEW IS IN A PROBATIONARY STATUS AND MAY BE DISMISSED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER.

(2) AFTER THE 1-YEAR PERIOD, THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION SERVES WITHOUT A FIXED TERM AND MAY BE REMOVED AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1207(G) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY.

SUBJECT TO THE POLICIES AND DIRECTIVES OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT AND THE JOINT BUDGET AND AUDIT COMMITTEE, THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET REVIEW HAS GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL OF THE OPERATION OF THE DIVISION.
