2-1408. "OFFICE" DEFINED.

IN THIS PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE, "OFFICE" MEANS THE LEGISLATIVE ACCOUNTING OFFICE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to avoid repetition of the full title "Legislative Accounting Office".

2-1409. ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A LEGISLATIVE ACCOUNTING OFFICE IN THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first and second clauses of the first sentence of former Art. 40, § 62(a).

It is set forth as a separate section for emphasis.

The reference to the "Legislative Branch of the State government" is substituted for the former, archaic reference to the "Legislative Department", to standardize references to the branches of the State government.
