

SECTION 2. CHAPTER 62

(House Bill 1044)

AN ACT concerning

Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Fee

FOR the purpose of increasing the license fee in Wicomico County for a Class B beer, wine, and liquor (on-sale) hotel license; and making this Act an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

19.

(a) A Class B beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located, and the license authorizes its
