(B) REQUIRED.

IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY PASSES AN EMERGENCY PUBLIC LOCAL LAW:

- (1) THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE, IF THE LAW IS A SENATE BILL, OR THE CHIEF CLERK OF THE HOUSE, IF THE LAW IS A HOUSE BILL, SHALL MAIL A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE LAW:
- (I) TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY TO WHICH THE LAW APPLIES; OR
- (II) IF THE LAW APPLIES TO BALTIMORE CITY, TO THE MAYOR; AND
- (2) THE COMMISSIONERS OR MAYOR SHALL HAVE THE LAW PUBLISHED, IN EACH NEWSPAPER THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OR MAYOR DESIGNATES.
 - (C) DESIGNATION OF NEWSPAPERS.
- (1) EXCEPT IN BALTIMORE CITY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL DESIGNATE 1 OR MORE NEWSPAPERS IN THE COUNTY.
- (2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE MAYOR SHALL DESIGNATE 1 OR MORE DAILY NEWSPAPERS THAT ARE PUBLISHED IN THE CITY.
- (3) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL DESIGNATE ANY 3 NEWSPAPERS THAT ARE PUBLISHED IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE COUNTY.
 - (D) TIMES FOR PUBLICATION.
- (1) EXCEPT IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE LAW SHALL BE PUBLISHED, IN EACH DESIGNATED NEWSPAPER, AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK FOR 3 SUCCESSIVE WEEKS.
- (2) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE LAW SHALL BE PUBLISHED AT LEAST ONCE IN EACH DESIGNATED NEWSPAPER.
