## 3-208. APPROPRIATION.

# (A) REQUIRED.

IN EACH BUDGET BILL FOR A FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE TERM OF A GOVERNOR EXPIRES, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION, TO THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES, OF THE MONEY NEEDED TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE.

#### (B) LIMITATION.

THE APPROPRIATION UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE MORE THAN \$50,000.

(C) REVERSION TO GENERAL FUND.

IF THE GOVERNOR-ELECT IS THE INCUMBENT GOVERNOR, THE APPROPRIATION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
