In subsection (d)(1) of this section, the former, archaic reference to "State reformatories" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the broad reference to a "State institution".

The second sentence of former Art. 32A, § 2, which required the Attorney General, deputies, and assistants to perform duties imposed by law, is deleted as surplusage.

6-107. POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

(A) BALTIMORE CITY ENTITIES.

THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS THE LEGAL ADVISER OF AND SHALL REPRESENT AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OF THE LEGAL WORK FOR:

- (1) THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS OF BALTIMORE CITY;
- (2) THE BOARD OF LIQUOR COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY; AND
 - (3) THE SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY.
 - (B) ANTITRUST MATTERS.
- (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY ADVISE OR REPRESENT A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, OR AGENTS AS TO A MATTER THAT RELATES TO STATE OR FEDERAL ANTITRUST LAW.
- (2) REPRESENTATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY INCLUDE AN APPEARANCE IN AN ACTION OR ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING TO DEFEND THE SUBDIVISION, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT.
- (3) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY REQUIRE A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO PAY INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COSTS OF DEFENDING THE SUBDIVISION IN AN ACTION OR PROCEEDING.
- (4) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT DEPRIVE ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF ANY RIGHT TO RETAIN COUNSEL, AT THE EXPENSE OF THE SUBDIVISION, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT.
