7-206. MARYLAND REGISTER.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN ISSUE OF THE REGISTER SHALL CONTAIN:

- (1) ON THE FIRST PAGE:
 - (I) THE CLOSING DATE AND HOUR OF THE ISSUE: AND
- (II) THE ISSUE DATE, WHICH SHALL BE THE DATE OF DEPOSIT IN THE UNITED STATES MAIL AND SHALL APPEAR PROMINENTLY; AND
- (2) THE TEXT OF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS THAT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE DIVISION BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE AND HOUR AND HAS NOT BEEN PUBLISHED PREVIOUSLY:
- (I) DURING EACH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:
- 1. A SYNOPSIS OF EACH BILL THAT IS INTRODUCED; AND
- 2. A SYNOPSIS OF EACH BILL THAT IS ENACTED;
- (II) EACH PROPOSED RULE OF COURT THAT THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS DIRECTS TO BE PUBLISHED:
- (III) EACH RULE OF COURT THAT THE COURT OF APPEALS ADOPTS OR PERMITS TO BE ADOPTED;
- (IV) THE HEARING CALENDAR OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;
- (V) EACH ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OR MEMORANDUM OF THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS OR OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS THAT THE CHIEF JUDGE DIRECTS TO BE PUBLISHED;
