

(C) FREE DISTRIBUTION.

THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL PROVIDE, WITHOUT CHARGE:

(1) TO EACH MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, EACH ISSUE OF THE REGISTER;

(2) TO THE ENOCH PRATT LIBRARY AND THE STATE LAW LIBRARY, 1 COPY OF:

(I) THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS;

(II) EACH ISSUE OF THE PERMANENT SUPPLEMENTS TO THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS; AND

(III) EACH ISSUE OF THE REGISTER; AND

(3) TO A JUDGE OF A STATE COURT EXCEPT THE ORPHANS' COURT, 1 COPY OF THE CURRENT CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS OR THE REGISTER THAT THE JUDGE REQUESTS.

7-217. OFFICIAL TEXT.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE OFFICIAL TEXT OF A DOCUMENT IS:

(1) UNTIL INCORPORATION IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS, THE TEXT OF THE DOCUMENT IN THE MOST RECENT FORM IN THE REGISTER; OR

(2) AFTER INCORPORATION IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS, THE TEXT OF THE DOCUMENT IN THE MOST RECENT FORM IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.

(B) ONLY VALID TEXT.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY DISCREPANCY BETWEEN THE OFFICIAL TEXT AND ANY OTHER TEXT OF A DOCUMENT, THE OFFICIAL TEXT IS THE ONLY VALID AND ENFORCEABLE TEXT.
