(C) FREE DISTRIBUTION.

THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL PROVIDE, WITHOUT CHARGE:

- (1) TO EACH MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, EACH ISSUE OF THE REGISTER;
- (2) TO THE ENOCH PRATT LIBRARY AND THE STATE LAW LIBRARY, 1 COPY OF:
 - (I) THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS;
- (II) EACH ISSUE OF THE PERMANENT SUPPLEMENTS TO THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS; AND
 - (III) EACH ISSUE OF THE REGISTER; AND
- (3) TO A JUDGE OF A STATE COURT EXCEPT THE ORPHANS' COURT, 1 COPY OF THE CURRENT CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS OR THE REGISTER THAT THE JUDGE REQUESTS.
