

(r) (2) (i) The Sheriff of Prince George's County shall be provided with ~~three~~ 4 full-time assistant sheriffs, and all assistant sheriffs shall be selected and appointed by the Sheriff and serve at his pleasure. ONE OF THE ASSISTANT SHERIFFS SHALL BE APPOINTED AS THE CHIEF ASSISTANT SHERIFF. The assistant sheriffs shall be considered line officers, if so designated by the Sheriff.

~~-3.-~~ ~~-2-~~ Be provided with an expense allowance of not more than [\$1,000] \$1,500 annually, an accounting of which shall be submitted to the County Director of Finance for approval.

~~-(iii)-~~ ~~{iv}~~ The assistant sheriffs shall devote their full time and attention to the office of Sheriff.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
