SUBTITLE 2. PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS.

8-201. ESTABLISHED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT SHALL HAVE NOT MORE THAN 20 PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS, EACH OF WHICH SHALL EMBRACE A BROAD, FUNCTIONAL AREA OF THAT BRANCH.

(B) ENUMERATED.

THE PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARE:

- (1) AGRICULTURE;
- (2) BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING;
- (3) ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT;
- (4) EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING;
- (5) GENERAL SERVICES;
- (6) HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;
- (7) HUMAN RESOURCES;
- (8) LICENSING AND REGULATION;
- (9) NATURAL RESOURCES;
- (10) PERSONNEL;
- (11) PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;
- (12) STATE PLANNING; AND
- (13) TRANSPORTATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 2A and the first and second sentences of § 2.

The third sentence of former Art. 41, § 2, which listed examples of broad, functional areas, is deleted as duplicative of subsection (b)(2) through (6) and (8) through (13) of this section.
