9-105. MEMBERSHIP OF COMMISSION.

(A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF '5 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS.

EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MUST BE A RESIDENT AND CITIZEN OF THE STATE.

- (C) TENURE; VACANCIES.
 - (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON OCTOBER 1, 1984.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
 - (D) REMOVAL.
- (1) SUBJECT TO THE HEARING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR CAUSE.
- (2) BEFORE THE GOVERNOR REMOVES A MEMBER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL GIVE THE MEMBER NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.
