(D) APPEALS.

THE COMMISSION MAY HEAR AND DECIDE AN APPEAL OF A DENIAL OF A LICENSE.

A LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ACT AS A STATE LOTTERY SALES AGENT WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL REQUIRE A BOND FROM EACH LICENSED AGENT IN THE AMOUNT THAT THE REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY SET.
