9-115. DISPLAY OF LICENSE.

EACH LICENSED AGENT SHALL DISPLAY PROMINENTLY THE LICENSE OR A COPY OF IT, AS THE REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY REQUIRE.

9-116. SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF LICENSE.

THE COMMISSION MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE, ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE DIRECTOR.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language substituted for former Art. 88D, § 8(g), which imposed on the Director the duty to recommend disciplinary action.

The substituted language states expressly that the Commission has the power to suspend or revoke a license and clarifies that action is taken on recommendation of the Director.

9-117. COMPENSATION OF LICENSED AGENTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

DURING A CALENDAR YEAR, A LICENSED AGENT MAY NOT RECEIVE REGULAR COMMISSIONS THAT EXCEED 5% OF THE LICENSED AGENT'S GROSS RECEIPTS FROM TICKET SALES MADE DURING THAT YEAR.
