- (B) BONUS OR INCENTIVE.
- (1) THE COMMISSION MAY AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF SPECIAL BONUSES OR INCENTIVES TO LICENSED AGENTS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES.
- (2) THE TOTAL OF THE BONUSES AND INCENTIVES MAY NOT EXCEED ONE-HALF OF 1% OF THE GROSS RECEIPTS FROM TICKET SALES FOR THE YEAR FOR WHICH THE BONUSES OR INCENTIVES ARE AWARDED.

9-118. STATE LOTTERY FUND.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A STATE LOTTERY FUND.

(B) COMPOSITION.
