9-123. INELIGIBLE TO BUY STATE LOTTERY TICKETS AND SHARES.

A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE MAY NOT BE BOUGHT BY AND A PRIZE MAY NOT BE GIVEN TO:

- (1) AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE AGENCY: OR
- (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A SPOUSE, CHILD, PARENT, OR SIBLING OF AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE AGENCY AND RESIDES IN THE PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE OF THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

- 9-124. PROHIBITED ACTS: PENALTIES.
 - (A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT:

- (1) GIVING A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AS A GIFT; OR
- (2) BUYING A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AS A GIFT FOR A MINOR.
 - (B) UNLAWFUL SALE OF TICKETS AND SHARES.

A PERSON OR GOVERNMENTAL UNIT MAY NOT:

- (1) UNLESS A LICENSED AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSED AGENT, SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE;
- (2) SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AT ANY PRICE OTHER THAN THE PRICE THAT THE REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY SET;
 - (3) SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE TO A MINOR:
- (4) KNOWINGLY PRESENT A COUNTERFEIT OR ALTERED STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE FOR PAYMENT; OR
