9-123. INELIGIBLE TO BUY STATE LOTTERY TICKETS AND SHARES.

A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE MAY NOT BE BOUGHT BY AND A PRIZE MAY NOT BE GIVEN TO:

(1) AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE AGENCY; OR

(2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A SPOUSE, CHILD, PARENT, OR SIBLING OF AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE AGENCY AND RESIDES IN THE PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE OF THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

In the introductory clause of this section, the term "State lottery" is added to modify the words "ticket or share", for clarity. See revisor's note to § 9-124 of this subtitle.

9-124. PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT:

(1) GIVING A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AS A GIFT;

OR

(2) BUYING A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AS A GIFT FOR A MINOR.

(B) UNLAWFUL SALE OF TICKETS AND SHARES.

A PERSON OR GOVERNMENTAL UNIT MAY NOT:

(1) UNLESS A LICENSED AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSED AGENT, SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE;

(2) SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE AT ANY PRICE OTHER THAN THE PRICE THAT THE REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY SET;

(3) SELL A STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE TO A MINOR;

(4) KNOWINGLY PRESENT A COUNTERFEIT OR ALTERED STATE LOTTERY TICKET OR SHARE FOR PAYMENT; OR
