SUBTITLE 3. OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

9-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) DIRECTOR.

"DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

(C) MINORITY PERSON.

(1) "MINORITY PERSON" MEANS:

(I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN DEPRIVED OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP AND KEEP A COMPETITIVE POSITION IN THE ECONOMY BECAUSE OF A SOCIAL OR ECONOMIC DISADVANTAGE THAT ARISES FROM CULTURAL, RACIAL, OR OTHER SIMILAR CAUSES; OR

(II) A SHELTERED WORKSHOP FOR HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS.

(2) "MINORITY PERSON" INCLUDES:

(I) AN ALEUT;

(II) AN AMERICAN INDIAN;
