In a letter dated February 20, 1950 and addressed to then Governor Lane, the Commission recommended its dissolution, and the Governor complied, in a letter to the Chairman of the Commission dated March 27, 1950.

SUBTITLE 1. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT -- REGULATIONS.

PART I. DEFINITIONS: GENERAL PROVISIONS.

10-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(D) REGISTER.
