- (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OR PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:
  - (I) CONTAIN THE FULL TEXT OF THE REGULATION;
- (II) SHOW EACH CHANGE IN THE TEXT WITH THE SYMBOLS THAT THE ADMINISTRATOR REQUIRES.

AND

- (2) IF THE TEXT OF THE ADOPTED REGULATION IS THE SAME OR SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE PROPOSED REGULATION, THE NOTICE SHALL:
- (I) STATE THAT THE TEXTS ARE THE SAME OR SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR;
- (II) CITE THE DATE OF THE REGISTER IN WHICH THE PROPOSED REGULATION WAS PUBLISHED; AND
- (III) SHOW EACH CHANGE IN THE TEXT WITH THE SYMBOLS THAT THE ADMINISTRATOR REQUIRES.
- (3) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMITTEE, THE NOTICE MAY CONTAIN A SYNOPSIS OF THE REGULATION IF, WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SYNOPSIS IS PUBLISHED, THE FULL TEXT WILL BE PUBLISHED IN THE PERMANENT SUPPLEMENTS TO THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.
  - REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a) and (b)(2) and (3) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 256F(d) and (e) and the second and third sentences of § 256D.

Subsection (b)(1) of this section is new language added to state expressly that which formerly only was implied by the exceptions in subsection (b)(2) and (3) of this section and  $\S$  10-113 of this subtitle.

Subsection (b)(3) of this section, as revised, clarifies that the publication of a synopsis applies only to an adopted regulation. This revision is based on  $\S$  7-205(b) of this article, which limits the contents of the permanent supplements.

As to the deletion of the first sentence of former Art. 41, § 256D, which required filing of documents to be published in the Code of Maryland Regulations, see revisor's note to § 7-213 of this article.

The fourth sentence of former Art. 41, § 256D, which exempted certain documents filed before July 1, 1974, is deleted as obsolete.
