SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

8-106.

(a) As used in this section, unless otherwise indicated, "mileage allowance" means the rate for each mile or fraction of a mile over five miles actually traveled by a juror going to and from court each day over the shortest practicable route.

(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated in this section for each day the juror attends court as a juror in:

(24) Worcester County--\$15 expense money; [15 cents mileage allowance] MILEAGE ALLOWANCE AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1984.
